

GALAHs Fifa2001 - Australian Kit 2001

Final Release

Features:

- The 2001 version of the Australian National side's (Socceroo) playing strip.
- The National Coat of Arm's and the Adidas logo.

Benefits:

- Playing strip constructed pixel-by-pixel maintaining the highest resolution and clarity possible. Huge improvement in quality compared to original in-game uniform for Australia.
- This is the strip design that should have been included in Fifa2001 not the 1999 style we had to put-up with!

System Requirements:

- EA Sports Fifa2001 to be installed
- An Internet Browser
- FEd2001
- Windows 9X systems requires WinZip, (WinRAR or similar) to be installed.

Installation Process:

- Download [fifa2001_AusKit2001.zip](#)
- Right click on Fifa2001_AusKit2001.zip, select [WinZip](#), [Extract to....](#)
- Extract the files into your Fifa2001 folder.
- You must use FEd2001 to insert the new kit. Get it from www.fifa2001.com or www.fifa2003.com download section.
- Install FEd2001 into your Fifa2001 folder.
- Run FEd2001.
- Now select from the right hand column -> [Others](#), [International](#)
- Then in the next box to your right select -> [Australia](#)
- Import the home (jh01415.fsh) and away (ja01415.fsh) kits [remember they are in your Fifa2001 folder]
- Save FEd2001 and close it.
- To configure the strips number colour, Start Fifa2001, select team customisation for Australia. You will see the new uniform design. The shirts colours cannot be changed, but you can use the middle colour bar to change the colour of the 'player number'. Deep Yellow is the most accurate to reality.
- Remember to do the previous step to both the Home and Away strips.
